A Urgent Maternal Warning Signs

Pregnant or gave birth within the last year?

If you have any of these urgent warning signs, call 9-1-1 or go to the nearest Emergency Room/OB Triage!



Headache that won't go away or gets worse over time, with or without vision changes





Trouble breathing Baby's movements stop or slow down



Seizures



Vaginal bleeding or fluid leaking during pregnancy



Severe belly pain that doesn't go away



Thoughts about hurting yourself or your baby

When you get to the Emergency Room/OB Triage, tell them:

Your name

You are pregnant or had a cesarean or vaginal delivery on (date)

Who your OB Provider is and where you delivered

The warning sign you are experiencing

Call your OB Provider and say you need to be seen today if you have any of these urgent maternal warning signs:



Fever



Extreme swelling of your hands or face



Leg pain, swelling or redness in your leg



Chest pain or fast-beating heart



Severe nausea and throwing up (not like morning sickness)



Dizziness or fainting



Overwhelming tiredness



Changes in your vision



Heavy vaginal bleeding (more than your period) after you give birth

When you reach the office or your OB Provider, tell them:

- Your name
- You are pregnant OR had a cesarean or vaginal delivery on (date)
- The warning sign you are experiencing and that you need to see/ speak to your provider today

If you cannot reach your OB Provider, go to the emergency room/OB Triage!
